

## **RESOLUTION ENACTING LOCAL LAW**

**WHEREAS**, Proposed Local Law No. 5 of 2020 of the Town of Huron would override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Clerk caused a copy of a Notice of a Public Hearing on proposed Local Law No. 5 of 2020 to be published in the *Times of Wayne County* on September 13, 2020, on the sign board of the Town maintained pursuant to Town Law §30(6) on September 10, 2020, and on the Town of Huron website (along with the proposed text of the law) on September 10, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Law has been on the desks of all Town Board members since September 1, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, adoption of Proposed Local Law No. 5 of 2020 would be routine or continuing agency administration and management, and related local legislative decisionmaking, and therefore is a Type II action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act, pursuant to 6 N.Y.C.R.R. §617.5(c)(20, 27); and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was duly held on that Proposed Local Law on September 21, 2020 at 6:20 PM before the Town Board at the Huron Town Hall, and all persons desiring to speak were heard;

**NOW**, on Motion duly made and seconded, it is

**RESOLVED** that, pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law and General Municipal Law §3-c (5), Proposed Local Law No. 5 of 2020 is hereby enacted, and shall be filed with the Secretary of State.
